

GCET Admission Procedure

Eligibility Criteria :

1. Candidates graduates from a University recognized and located in Gujarat State are eligible to appear for GCET.
2. Candidates who have graduated in a 3-year course from a University outside Gujarat State but have passed Std. XII or its equivalent examination from a recognized school located in Gujarat State are also eligible to appear for GCET.
3. Candidates must have passed Std. XII (HSC) examination or its equivalent examinations with Mathematics/Business Mathematics/Statistics as one of the subjects. (Graduate who have taken Mathematics as one of the subjects for graduation will also be eligible).
4. The candidate have passed graduation in any discipline, including BCA course from a university located in the State of Gujarat.
5. A candidate who has appeared at the final year (Bachelor's Degree) examination of any University recognized by the Association of Indian Universities (subject to condition 1 to 4 above) shall be treated as provisionally eligible for GCET.
6. For wards of Kashmiri migrants, one supernumerary seat will be allotted in each institution where the seats are filled by the GCET Committee, based on a separate merit list prepared for the purpose. In their case, the eligibility conditions mentioned at 1 and 2 will not be applicable.

Entrance Test :

The entrance test will be in English only. There will be 250 questions of objective nature, with each question having four alternative answers. There will be negative marking 25% of the marks allotted to the question for wrong answers. The aspects to be covered will be Quantitative Ability; Analytical and Logical Reasoning; Language Ability; Mathematics/Business Mathematics/ Statistics up to 12th standard of Gujarat HSC Board level.

Result :

After some days the result will be displayed in the website of GCET. According to this result merit the seats will allocated.

Allocation of seats :

1. Admission to all seats in Government, Grant-in-aid institutions and institutions run by universities will be given by the GCET Committee/
2. If private unaided institutions surrender their sanctioned seats to GCET Committee, then such seats will be filled by the committee as per Government Resolution (GR).
3. Admission given by Centralized Procedure by Unaided Private Institutions as per the order of Hon'ble Supreme Court shall be submitted to the GCET committee for endorsement. The concerned university shall enroll students based on such endorsed list only.
4. The private unaided institutions shall carry out admission proceedings based on the GCET merit as per the guidelines issued.
